- 1,180 KILOS OF COCAINE BASE DESTROYED.
- 26 LABORATORY COMPLEXES RAIDED AND DESTROYED.
- 20 PERSONS ARRESTED. ALL PERSONS WERE CAMPESINOS LIVING NEAR THE LABS. NO JUDICIAL ACTION IS ANTICIPATED.

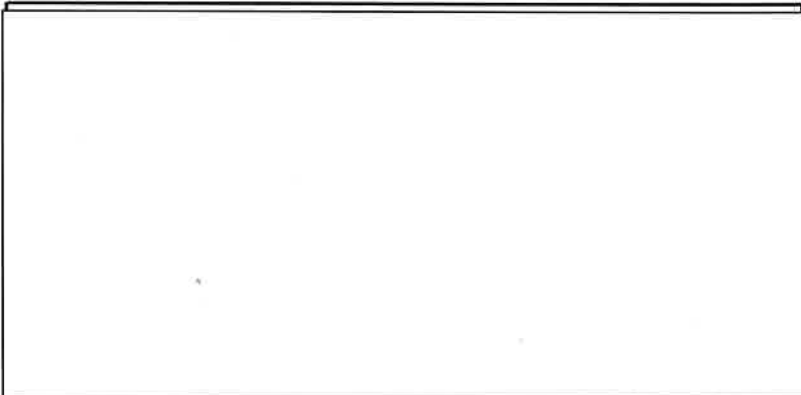
