1. ON 26 SEPTEMBER 1990 THE COLOMBIAN NATIONAL POLICE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF VALLE DEL CAUCA REPORTED THE MASSACRE OF EIGHTEEN PEOPLE AT HACIENDA LOS COCOS NEAR THE MUNICIPALITY OF CANDELARIA. CANDELARIA IS LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 30 KILOMETERS EAST OF CALI. THE HACIENDA IS ALLEGEDLY THE PROPERTY OF (b)(7)(C)

(b)(7)(C) A HIGH RANKING MEMBER OF THE CALI CARTEL. ALL PERSONS HAVE NOT BEEN IDENTIFIED AS YET, NAMES OF IDENTIFIED WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE INDEXING SECTION.

2. PRELIMINARY INDICATIONS POINT TO A CONTINUATION OF THE CONFLICT BETWEEN THE CARTELS OF MEDELLIN AND CALI. REPORTS FROM THE POLICE ALSO INCLUDE A LIST OF FOUR PEOPLE THAT WERE INJURED DURING THIS MASSACRE. THE MASSACRE WAS ACCOMPLISHED BY PERSONS DRESSED AND IDENTIFIED AS COLOMBIAN NATIONAL POLICE ANTINARCOTICS AGENTS.

3. ON 27 SEPTEMBER 1990 THE COLOMBIAN NATIONAL POLICE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CAUCA REPORTED THE SEIZURE OF NUMEROUS WEAPONS. THESE WEAPONS AND ITEMS WERE BURIED IN BARRELS AT FINCH UBICADA NEAR THE MUNICIPALITY OF SANTANDER DE QUILICHAO. IT WAS REPORTED THAT 15 AR-15 RIFLES, 2 GALLIL RIFLES, 4 M-14 RIFLES, 3 5.56 MM AUG RIFLES, 800 ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION, 1 FRAGMENTATION GRENADE ALONG WITH 2 RADIOS (COMMUNICATION) WERE SEIZED.

IN ADDITION, 36 RIFLE MAGAZINES, 21 ROPES, 27 ARMOUR DEVICES, 14 MAGAZINE LOADERS, 16 CAMOUFLAGE SHIRTS, 20 PAIRS OF CAMOUFLAGE PANTS, 40 SHIRTS, 51 PAIRS OF BOOTS, 11 HATS FROM THE CNP ANTINARCOTICS SQUAD AND 36 PAIR OF POLICE PANTS WERE SEIZED. FURTHER IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION REGARDING THE SEIZED WEAPONS AND RADIOS WERE NOT AVAILABLE AT PRESENT TIME AND WILL BE REPORTED WHEN OBTAINED BY THE BCO. BCO IS COORDINATING THIS WITH THE COLOMBIAN NATIONAL POLICE AND THE BOGOTA REPRESENTATIVE OF THE U.S. ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND FIREARMS.

4. ON 28 SEPTEMBER 1990 THE COLOMBIAN NATIONAL POLICE ADVISED THE BCO OF THE ARRESTS OF FOUR PERSONS INVOLVED IN THE MASSACRE AND THE CONCEALMENT OF THE WEAPONS. THE FOUR WERE IDENTIFIED (b)(7)(C)

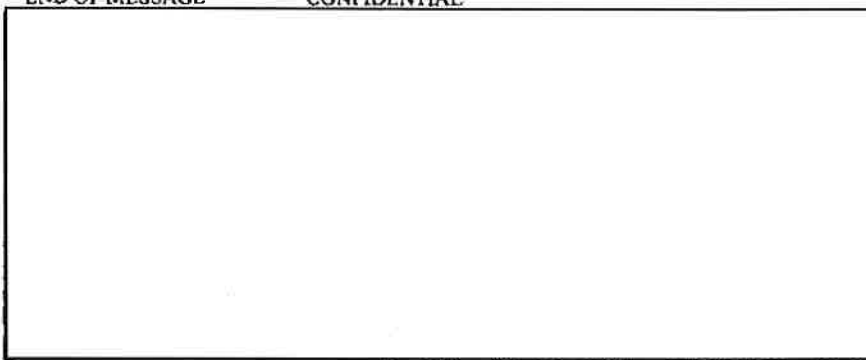
