Colombia: (U) According to press reporting, a Colombian judge issued an arrest warrant on 14 June for drug kingpin Pablo Escobar Gaviria. The warrant reportedly seeks Escobar's arrest on suspicion of ordering the 1989 assassination of presidential aspirant Luis Carlos Galan. The timing of the warrant is puzzling, given the prominent public speculation that Escobar is close to finalizing an agreement with the government for his surrender. The judge's action therefore appears to have been taken independently of the government's negotiations with Escobar.
