SUMMARY: (U) GUERRILLA ACTIVITY PICKS UP, ESPECIALLY IN THE BANANA-GROWING URABA REGION. THE ARMY AND POLIC MAKE IMPRESSIVE GAINS IN THE CAPTURE OF SOME GUERRILLA LEADERS IN ALL GROUPS, BUT PARTICULARLY IN THE EPL/D. ESCOBAR BEGINS HIS "GUERRILLA" CAMPAIGN.

TEXT: 1. (U) THIS IIR REPORTS KEY GUERRILLA ACTIVITIES, GOVERNMENT AND MILITARY COUNTER-GUERRILLA RESPONSES, AND PUBLIC CONCERN AS REPORTED IN THE PRESS DURING THE PERIOD 930121-930131.

2. THE FOLLOWING EVENTS ARE PRESENTED CHRONOLOGICALLY AS COVERED BY MEDIA SOURCES. THE SITES OF THE ACTIONS ARE IDENTIFIED BY THE NEAREST COMMUNITY AND THE DEPARTMENT. THE CGSB (COORDINADORA GUERRILLERO SIMON BOLIVAR) IS THE CONFEDERATION OF VARIOUS GUERRILLA GROUPS. THE GROUPS ARE THE FARC (FUERZAS ARMADAS REVOLUCIONARIAS DE COLOMBIA), THE ELN (EJERCITO DE LIBERACION NACIONAL) AND THE EPL/D, THE DISSIDENT FACTION OF THE EPL (EJERCITO POPULAR DE LIBERACION), ALSO KNOWN AS THE FRANCISCO CARABELLO GROUP.

930121 -- BOGOTA. "GALAN", GERARDO ((BERMUDEZ)) SANCHEZ, FORMERLY THE ELN'S NUMBER THREE IN LINE BEFORE

BEING CAPTURED TWO MONTHS AGO, WAS PERMITTED TO GIVE HIS FIRST INTERVIEW FROM PRISON. GALAN CLAIMED TO CONTINUE TO BE PUBLIC SPOKESMAN FOR THE ELN. HE FURTHER CLAIMED THE ELN WOULD PARTICIPATE IN THE 1994 ELECTIONS. THE NEWS WAS TREATED WITH SKEPTICISM BY AUTHORITIES WHO NOTED THAT THE ELN HAD NEVER BEFORE WANTED TO ENTER LEGAL POLITICS, EVEN WHEN THEY WERE PARTICIPATING IN PEACE TALKS WITH THE GOVERNMENT.

930121 -- EL COCUY, BOYACA. TEN FARC 28TH FRONT GUERRILLAS FORCED THEIR WAY INTO TWO BANKS IN THIS TOWN IN THE EARLY MORNING, STOLE 48.5 MILLION PESOS (USD 65,000), BUT HARMED NO ONE.

930122 -- URABA AREA, ANTIOQUIA. AN ESTIMATED 200 CGSB GUERRILLAS MASSES TO ATTACK FOUR TARGETS IN THE AREA CAUSING ABOUT 700 MILLION PESOS DAMAGE (USD 950,000). IN THE AFTERMATH THE ARMY SUFFERED ONE DEAD AND SIX WOUNDED WHILE IN PURSUIT. ONE TARGET, AN ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION IN APARTADO, WAS DESTROYED LEAVING SIX COMMUNITIES WITHOUT POWER. A SECOND TARGET, A KEY HIGHWAY BRIDGE NEAR TURBO, WAS ONLY LIGHTLY DAMAGED. THE THIRD TARGET WAS A BANANA PLANTATION, WHERE 20 GUERRILLAS FORCED 350 WORKERS ONTO A SOCCER FIELD WHILE THEY BURNED THE WORKERS' CAMPSITES, SOME TRUCKS, WAREHOUSES AND OFFICES. THE FOURTH TARGET, A POLICE OUTPOST OUTSIDE OF APARTADO, WAS ATTACKED BY 30 GUERRILLAS AND DESTROYED. THE ATTACKS WERE PROBABLY THE WORK OF A COMBINATION OF SEVERAL GUERRILLA GROUPS. THE AREA IS INFESTED BY THE 5TH AND 34TH FRONTS OF THE FARC THE ELN'S "MARTIRES DE URABA" FRONT, THE FRANCISCO CARABELLO GROUP, AND URBAN CELLS CALLED MILICIAS BOLIVARIANAS.

930122 -- SINCELEJO, SUCRE. USING INFORMATION PROVIDED BY A PRIVATE CITIZEN, POLICE AND DAS (DEPARTAMENTO ADMINISTRATIVO DE SEGURIDAD) CAPTURED RAFAEL IGNACIO ((CABRALES)) ALVAREZ, AT A BUS DEPOT. CABRALES IS LEADER OF THE EPL/D IN URABA, AND IS ALSO ALLEGEDLY INVOLVED IN THE RECENT ASSASSINATION OF THE MAYOR OF SA PEDRO DE URABA.

SOLDIER DIED IN A CLASH IN A RURAL AREA NEAR THE CITY.

930123 -- SARAVENA, ARAUCA. GOVERNMENT AND MILITARY PARTICIPANTS MEETING IN THIS TOWN BEMOANED THE GROWTH OF GUERRILLA STRENGTH IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ARAUCA AND THE USE OF THE CITY OF ARAUCA AS A VACATION CENTER FOR GUERRILLAS. SPURRED BY THE RICHES OF ARAUCA THE GUERRILLAS HAVE MASSED HERE DESPITE THE REINFORCEMENT OF THE ARMY IN THE REGION.

930123 -- BUCARAMANGA, SANTANDER. 5TH BRIGADE TROOPS INTERCEPTED FOUR ELN GUERRILLAS OF THE EFRAIN PABON PABON FRONT WHO HAD JUST KIDNAPPED A WOMAN AND STOLEN A TRUCK. ALL FOUR DIED IN THE SUCCESSFUL RESCUE.

930123 -- AGUACHICA, CESAR. COUNTERGUERRILLA POLICE DISCOVERED AN ELN (CAMILO TORRES FRONT) CACHE OF ARMS. 84 UNIFORMS, 1100 RIFLE ROUNDS, 570 R-15 ROUNDS, 16 BOMBS, 70 DETONATORS, 200 METERS OF CABLE AND OTHER ITEMS WERE SEIZED.

930123 -- BOGOTA. THE ARMY LAUNCHED A NEW LEAFLET CAMPAIGN TO ENTICE FARC AND ELN GUERRILLAS TO GIVE UP. FASHIONED AFTER THE US PSYOPS EFFORT DURING THE PERSIAN GULF WAR THE LEAFLETS URGE DESERTION AND PROVIDE A SAFE PASSAGE GUARANTEE. THE LEAFLETS FOR THE FIRST TIME REFER TO THE GUERRILLAS AS GUERRILLAS INSTEAD OF BANDIT OR CRIMINALS.

930123 -- URABA, ANTIOQUIA. ARMY ACTIONS CONTINUED IN THE REGION AFTER THE CGSB ATTACKS OF LAST FRIDAY. NEAR APARTADO AND TURBO CONTACTS BETWEEN THE FARC 5TH FRONT AND THE LST OPERATIVE COMMAND RESULTED IN AN ESTIMATED THREE TO FIVE GUERRILLAS AND ONE SOLDIER DEAD, PLUS NINE MORE SOLDIERS WOUNDED. AT MUTATA, A SOLDIER AND THE VISITING MOTHER OF ANOTHER SOLDIER DIED AS FARC GUERRILLAS ATTACKED A UNIT IN BROAD DAYLIGHT IN THE TOWN CENTER. FOUR GUERRILLAS DIED IN THE BATTLE, AND TWO MORE WERE KILLED AS POLICE REACTED TO PURSUE.

930123 -- **BOGOTA.** IN AN INTERVIEW WITH SOURCE B THE ARMY COMMANDER OUTLINED A NEW INTENSIVE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS AND UNITS TO PREVENT HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES. IN ADDITION, THE ARMY HAS ALREADY INTENSIFIED ITS INVESTIGATIONS OF ALLEGED ABUSES AND HAS A SYSTEM OF UNIT INSPECTION TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE.

930123 -- **SINCELEJO, SUCRE.** ANOTHER LEADER OF THE EPL/D FELL WHEN THE DAS KILLED MIGUEL JOSE ((RAMOS)) CLEMENTE A CHIEF OF FINANCES FOR THE GROUP, IN AN OUTLYING AREA OF THIS COMMUNITY. VARIOUS EQUIPMENT AND DOCUMENTS WERE ALSO SEIZED.

930131 -- GIRADOT, CUNDINAMARCA. A STUDY BY THE MAYOR AND POLICE FOUND GUERRILLA INFILTRATION IN SOME OF THE TOWN'S JUVENILE GANGS. GUERRILLA ORGANIZATIONS EXPECT TO EVENTUALLY TURN THE GANGS INTO URBAN CELLS, BUT CAN MAKE GOOD USE OF THEM IN CONVENTIONAL GANG ACTIVITIES, FROM GRAFFITI FOR PROPAGANDA TO STEALING VEHICLES. THE PRACTICE OF USING GANGS MAY ACTUALLY BE WELL USED IN TH LARGER CITIES ALREADY.

930131 -- SAN PEDRO DE URABA, ANTIOQUIA. THE ARMY'S OPERATIVE COMMAND NO.L PURSUED AND KILLED THE PRESUMED AUTHOR OF THE EPL/D KIDNAP AND MURDER OF ALIRIO ((GUEVARA)), THE VICE PRESIDENT OF THE FARM WORKERS UNION THAT CAUSED AN UPROAR IN URABA OVER THE LAST FEW DAYS.
