7. JUDICIAL ISSUES.

A. ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE -- GENERAL:

- ON NOVEMBER FIRST, THE PROCURADORIA APPOINTED A NEW DELEGATE PROCURADOR FOR HUMAN RIGHTS, HERNAN VALENCIA VILLA. A FORMER LAW PROFESSOR AND LONGTIME VETERAN OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS COMMUNITY, VALENCIA IS CHARGED WITH INVESTIGATING REPORTS OF SERIOUS HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES, TORTURE, AND DISAPPEARANCES ALLEGEDLY COMMITTED BY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES. VALENCIA APPEARS COMMITTED TO INVIGORATING AN OFFICE THAT HAS BEEN CRITICIZED FOR INACTIVITY.

- ON NOVEMBER 19, COLOMBIA AND PANAMA SIGNED A MUTUAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE TREATY PROVIDING FOR THE EXCHANGE OF A WIDE VARIETY OF LEGAL ASSISTANCE IN CONNECTION WITH THE INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION OF NARCOTICS-RELATED CASES, INCLUDING MONEY LAUNDERING AND ASSET SEIZURE SHARING.

- FOLLOWING HIS ATTENDANCE AT AN INTERNATIONAL DRUG CONFERENCE IN BALTIMORE, FISCAL GENERAL DE GREIFF MET ON NOVEMBER 18 WITH DOJ AND STATE OFFICIALS. DE GREIFF NOT ONLY SUPPORTED EVENTUAL, WORLD-WIDE LEGALIZATION BECAUSE THE DRUG WAR IS A LOST CAUSE BUT ALSO JUSTIFIED LENIENT

TERMS FOR SURRENDERING NARCOTRAFFICKERS. IN A FULL-PAGE INTERVIEW CARRIED ON NOVEMBER 28 BY EL TIEMPO, GUSTAVO DE GREIFF WENT ON RECORD AS SUPPORTING LEGALIZATION AS THE ONLY PLAUSIBLE MEANS OF CONTROLLING TRAFFICKING. DE GREIFF ALSO POINTED OUT A FAILED DRUG STRATEGY BY THE US THAT HAS MISTAKENLY CONCENTRATED ON ERADICATION AND INTERDICTION RATHER THAN CONSUMER DEMAND.

- ON NOVEMBER 30, PROCURADOR GENERAL ARRIETA MET WITH ACTING ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR HUMAN RIGHTS ELY-RAPHEL IN WASHINGTON. ARRIETA HIGHLIGHTED THE WORK BEING DONE BY THE PROCURADORIA TO ENCOURAGE POLICE REFORM AND TO INSTILL HUMAN RIGHTS VALUES IN THE POLICE AND MILITARY.

B. FISCALIA AND COURT ACTIONS:

- ON NOVEMBER 4, THE FISCALIA ISSUED AN ARREST WARRANT FOR GILBERTO RODRIGUEZ OREJUELA FOR NARCOTRAFFICKING AND ILLICIT ENRICHMENT. THIS IS THE THIRD LEGAL ACTION TAKEN AGAINST THE RODRIGUEZ OREJUELA BROTHERS.

- ALSO ON NOVEMBER 4, THE FISCALIA ISSUED ANOTHER ARREST WARRANT AGAINST PABLO ESCOBAR, THIS TIME FOR NOT SHOWING UP TO TESTIFY IN THE 1990 KIDNAPPING OF THE CURRENT MINISTER OF EDUCATION, MARUJA PACHON DE VILLAMIZAR AND HER COUSIN, THE THE MURDER OF THEIR DRIVER.

- ON NOVEMBER 20, BOGOTA'S PUBLIC ORDER COURT RELEASED GONZALO MEJIA SANIN WHO WAS THE FIRST NARCOTRAFFICKER THAT SURRENDERED (IN NOVEMBER 1990) AND SERVED TWO YEARS AND NINE MONTHS. MEJIA WAS THE THIRD RANKING LEADER OF THE MEDELLIN CARTEL.

- ON NOVEMBER 26, THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT DECLARED KEY ARTICLES OF THE KIDNAPPING LAW UNCONSTITUTIONAL. THE COURT RULED THAT THE GOVERNMENT COULD NOT CRIMINALIZE THE PARTICIPATION BY VICTIMS' FAMILIES IN RANSOME NEGOTIATIONS AND PAYMENT TO KIDNAPPERS. NOR MAY THE GOC FREEZE THE FINANCIAL ASSETS OF VICTIMS, THE FAMILIES, AND THEIR BUSINESSES TO PREVENT RANSOM PAYMENT.

C. PRISONS:

- ON NOVEMBER 24, A COMPLETELY BURNED AND CHOPPED UP BODY WAS UNCOVERED BURIED IN THE MINI-SOCCER FIELD OF CATEDRAL PRISON. THE AUTHORITIES REPORTED THAT THIS BODY COULD SERVE AS VALUABLE EVIDENCE IN THE INVESTIGATION AGAINST ESCOBAR AND HIS LIEUTENANTS. TWO DAYS LATER, THE FISCALIA REVEALED THAT THE REMAINS BELONGED TO FERNANDO GALEANO (EL NEGRO).

8. INSTITUTION BUILDING.

A. PROJECT AGREEMENTS AND STATUS:

- ON NOVEMBER 2, EL ESPECTADOR REPORTED THAT THE GOC'S NATIONAL REHABILITATION OFFICE (PNR) TURNED OVER THE EQUIVALENT OF USD 350,000 TO THE INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES IN CAUCA DEPARTMENT FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS. THIS WAS THE FIRST PAYMENT TO FINANCE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS UNDER A MAY 1993 AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOC AND THE COMMUNITIES TO ERADICATE VOLUNTARILY THEIR CULTIVATIONS OF OPIUM POPPY. SIXTY PERCENT OF THE FUNDING WAS PROVIDED BY USAID USING ESF-GENERATED PESOS.

- CONFERENCES/MEETINGS:

- ON NOVEMBER 17, DIRAN STAFF AND EMBASSY/DOD PERSONNEL CONDUCTED AN FMS CASE REVIEW. THE STATUS OF EXISTING CASES WAS REVIEWED AND RECOMMENDATIONS WERE PREPARED FOR NEW CASES. CURRENTLY, CNP CASES CONSTITUTE 18 PERCENT OF TOTAL COLOMBIAN FMS CASES AND 12 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL DOLLAR AMOUNT.

C. TRAINING:

- FROM OCTOBER 27-NOVEMBER 5, 17 DISAP OFFICERS AND ENLISTED PERSONNEL RECEIVED TRAINING IN THE OPERATION OF THE U.S. AIR FORCE'S AIMS INVENTORY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AT DISAP'S GUAYMARAL BASE NEAR BOGOTA.

- DISAP'S C-47 (PNC-212) COMPLETED INSPECTION AT THE

BASLER FACTORY IN OSHKOSH, WI., AND RETURNED TO COLOMBIA ON NOVEMBER 5. FROM 27 OCTOBER-5 NOVEMBER, FOUR DISAP C-47 COPILOTS ATTENDED THE C-47 TURBO GROUND SCHOOL AND FLIGHT TRAINING AT BASLER.

- FROM NOVEMBER 1-7, LUIS FERNANDO DUQUE AND EDGAR RODRIGUEZ VISITED WASHINGTON, BALTIMORE, AND PITTSBURG TO CONSULT ON PREPARATION OF MONOGRAPHS BASED ON THE 92/93 COLOMBIAN DRUG HOUSEHOLD SURVEY. THESE VISITS WERE ARRANGED BY NIDA.

- FROM NOVEMBER 6-13, THREE DISAP NCO'S ATTENDED A UH-1H HYDROLIC SERVO REPAIR COURSE AT A COMMERCIAL FACILITY IN LOS ANGELES, CA.

- FROM 13-26 NOVEMBER, FIVE DISAP PILOTS ATTENDED THE DEHAVILLAND TWIN OTTER (DHC-6) PILOT COURSE IN TORONTO, CANADA.

- FROM 24-30 NOVEMBER, ONE DISAP T-65 PILOT RECEIVED INSTRUCTOR TRAINING IN GUATEMALA.

- DURING THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 29, ICITAP SPONSORED A HUMAN DIGNITY COURSE IN BOGOTA FOR 28 HIGH-RANKING POLICE AND JUDICIAL OFFICIALS. THE COURSE, TAUGHT BY TWO INSTRUCTORS FROM NEW YORK'S JOHN JAY COLLEGE OF CRIMINOLOGY, FOCUSED ON HUMAN RIGHTS POLICE-COMMUNITY RELATIONS, PARTICULARLY WITH INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES. THIS COURSE WAS BOTH TIMELY AND WELL RECEIVED.

9. ECONOMIC/FINANCIAL ISSUES:

- ON NOVEMBER 17, A LUXEMBOURG JUSTICE MINISTRY OFFICIAL STATED PUBLICLY THAT THE CALI CARTEL MONEY WOULD REMAIN BLOCKED PENDING FURTHER JUDICIAL PROCESS, DESDPITE AN
- IN LATE NOVEMBER, THE USG RECEIVED AN ADDITIONAL 570,000 DOLLARS IN ASSETS BELONGING TO RODRIGUEZ GACHA THAT HAD BEEN SEIZED IN THE UK.

- A NOVEMBER 26 ARTICLE IN EL TIEMPO REPORTED ON A STORY IN LE MONDE DESCRIBING HOW THE COLOMBIAN CARTELS HAVE SPREAD THEIR ACTIVITIES, ESPECIALLY MONEY LAUNDERING, TO OTHER LATIN COUNTRIES, PARTICULARLY CHILE, VENEZUELA, AND BRAZIL.

10. DEMAND REDUCTION/DRUG PREVENTION AND TREATMENT:

- FROM NOVEMBER 3-6 THE CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY SPONSORED A CONFERENCE DRUG TREATMENT AND THE REHABILITATION OF THE CRIMINAL ADDICT. NAS AND USIS SPONSORED THE RESPECTIVE PARTICIPATION OF DR. NEIL ROSENBERG, DIRECTOR OF THE INTERNATIONAL INHALENT ABUSE CENTER IN BOULDER, COLORADO, AND MR. GUS FRIAS, EXPERT IN YOUTH VIOLENCE IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA. IN ADDITION TO SPEAKING AT THE CONFERENCE, BOTH EXPERTS CONDUCTED SPECIAL SEMINARS AND VISITED VARIOUS PROJECTS. THEY ALSO SPOKE BEFORE THE AMERICAN SCHOOL.

- ON NOVEMBER 26, THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS INAUGURATED IN LETICIA A DRUG PREVENTION EDUCATION CAMPAIGN FUNDED BY UNDCP.

11. PUBLIC DIPLOMACY AND MEDIA ISSUES:

- ON NOVEMBER 6, EL ESPECTADOR REPORTED THAT PRESIDENT CLINTON SIGNED EXECUTIVE ORDER 14 REGARDING FOREIGN COOPERATION AND ASSISTANCE FOR DRUG PRODUCING COUNTRIES. IT NOTED THE NEW EMPHASIS ON ATTACKING THE DRUG ORGANIZATIONS AND MORE FLEXIBILITY IN APPLYING INTERDICTION PROGRAMS.

- THE NOVEMBER 4-11 EDITION OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE COLOMBIA POST REPORTED ON THE "MAJOR SHIFT IN U.S. DRUG WAR TACTICS." IT SAID WASHINGTON WOULD NOW FOCUS ON LABORATORIES AND DRUG KINGPINS ABROAD AND EDUCATION
- ON NOVEMBER 17, EL TIEMPO CARRIED REMARKS MADE BY GUSTAVO DE GREIFF DURING A DRUG CONFERENCE IN BALTIMORE. DE GREIFF COMMENTED ON THE "FAILURE" OF THE

DRUG WAR DUE TO INCREASING DEMAND IN THE DEVELOPED COUNTRIES, NOTING THE THE "COMMERCIALIZATION" OF DRUGS COULD BE AN ALTERNATIVE. FOLLOWING VARIOUS PUBLIC STATEMENTS BY PRESIDENT GAVIRIA REJECTING DE GRIEFF'S POSITION, A NOVEMBER 21 ARTICLE QUOTED DE GRIEFF AS SAYING THAT HE NEVER SPOKE IN FAVOR OF LEGALIZATION AND THAT HIS REMARKS WERE TAKEN OUT OF CONTEXT BY THE MEDIA. A NOVEMBER 23 ARTICLE IN NUEVO SIGLO REPORTED THE REMARKS OF SENATOR GOMEZ HURTADO AT THE SAME BALTIMORE CONFERENCE. GOMEZ ECHOED DE GRIEFF'S EVALUATION OF THE DRUG WAR AND ADVOCATED DECRIMINALIZATION AS THE SOLUTION.

- ON NOVEMBER 22, TWO BOGOTA DAILIES CARRIED STORIES BASED ON THE 60 MINUTES INTERVIEW WITH FORMER DEA DIRECTOR BONNER CONCERNING THE 1990-1991 CIA OPERATION TO SHIP TWO TONS OF MEDELLIN CARTEL COCAINE TO THE U.S. VIA VENEZUELA.

- LA PRENSA REPORTED ON NOVEMBER 23 THAT NARCO KINGPIN IVAN URDINOLA COULD BE RELEASED FROM JAIL AS EARLY AS FEBRUARY 1994 AS A RESULT OF THE REVISED CRIMINAL PROCEDURES CODE ALLOWING FOR REDUCED SENTENCES FOR COOPERATION AND GOOD BEHAVIOR.

- ON NOVEMBER 28, DE GREIFF AGAIN WAS QUOTED IN EL TIEMPO AS SAYING THAT, IF CONSUMPTION IS BEING DECRIMINALIZED (IN THE DEVELOPING WORLD), THEN TRAFFICKING SHOULD ALSO BE DECRIMINALIZED IN ORDER TO TAKE THE PROFITABILITY OUT OF THE BUSINESS.

- AN OP-ED PIECE IN NOVEMBER 28'S EL ESPECTADOR TOOK ISSUE WITH DE GREIFF, SAYING THE EUROPEAN EXPERIENCE OF LEGALIZATION HAS BEEN AN "ABSOLUTE FAILURE."

- ALL THE MAJOR BOGOTA DAILIES AGAIN FOCUSED ON THE ISSUE OF LEGALIZATION DURING THE NOVEMBER 30/31 WEEKEND. THEY PRINTED PRESIDENT GAVIRIA'S PUBLIC LETTER TO DE GREIFF, STATING THAT LEGALIZATION WAS NOT THE PATH THAT COLOMBIA WOULD TAKE AND SOLIDIFYING COLOMBIA'S

- FROM NOVEMBER 2-17, A FIVE-MAN TREAM FROM SOCSOUTH AND USARSO PROVIDED AVIATION MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE TO DISAP. THE TEAM ASSISTED DISAP IN COMPLETING TWO PHASE INSPECTIONS AND IN RAISING THE HELO READY RATE FROM 39 TO 54 PERCENT.

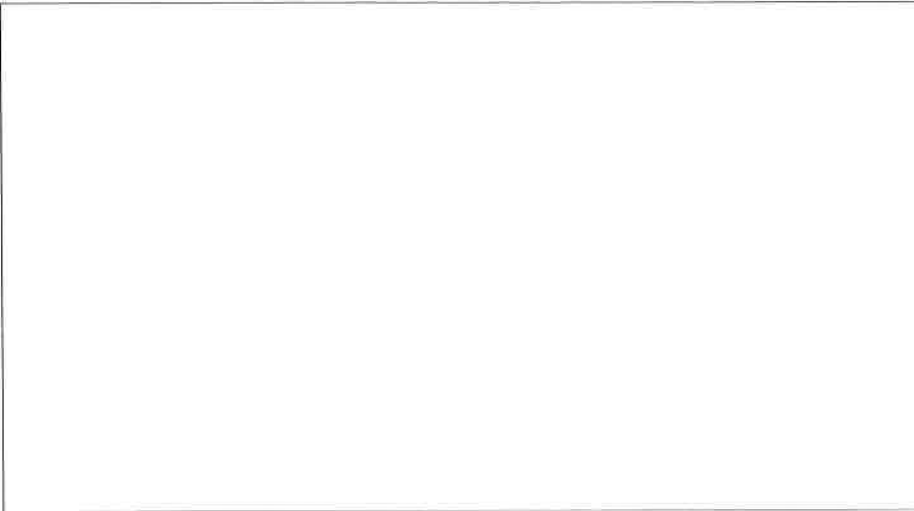
