(U) A. ~~(S)~~ COLOMBIA: A POWERFUL CAR BOMB EXPLODED IN A COMMERCIAL SECTION OF NORTH BOGOTA AT 1440 ON 15 APR. PRELIMINARY REPORTS INDICATED BETWEEN FIVE AND TEN WERE KILLED AND 40 INJURED WHEN A RENAULT EXPLODED IN THE PARKING LOT IN FRONT OF THE CENTRO 93 SHOPPING CENTER, CLOSE TO SEVERAL EMBASSY EMPLOYEE RESIDENCES AND A FEW BLOCKS FROM THE MARINE HOUSE. APPARENTLY FOUR PERSONS WERE ARRESTED ABOUT 15 MINUTES AFTER THE EXPLOSION. THERE MAY HAVE BEEN A WARNING OF THE BOMBING. THE GOVT OF COLOMBIA HAD INFORMED THE EMBASSY EARLIER OF A LETTER RECEIVED BY THE COLOMBIAN TAX OFFICE, THREATENING RENEWED BOMBINGS AGAINST MAJOR COMMERCIAL CENTERS. THE LETTER WAS SIGNED "ANTIOQUIA REBELDE," THE NAME OF THE POLITICAL/TERRORIST GROUP MEDELLIN DRUG LORD PABLO ESCOBAR CLAIMED TO HAVE FORMED EARLIER THIS YEAR. (AMEMBASSY BOGOTA 152129Z APR 93)
